Reporting directly to the UK Safety & Security Director, the successful applicant will also work closely with the Operational Management within Henry Schein Animal health to ensure all safety and security factors are identified and managed appropriately. Due to the requirements of the role, the successful applicant will remains on call 24 hours / 7 days so as to respond to alarm activations or other emergencies.

The role is varied and wide ranging. Some examples of the types of activity it will be responsible for are:

- Conducting security and safety audits and inspections on a regular basis.
- Chairing the facility's Health & Safety Committee.
- · Conducting security and safety training.
- Overseeing and coordinating the activities of the site's First Aid Responders, including training.

Ideally you should have a minimum of 5 years security, safety or law enforcement experience in a supervisory capacity. Previous experience in a warehouse or distribution environment is helpful. A basic knowledge of alarm systems and security technology is required. As a confident communicator you will have the ability to interface with all levels. As somebody who will work on security and safety issues on a daily basis, you will have the highest degree of integrity and confidentiality. You will be self-motivated and have the ability to work with little direct supervision and handle multiple tasks. Capable at managing your own workloads, you will be organized and detail oriented.
